The Charlie Jones Memorial Scholarship APPLICATION AND GUIDELINES

The family of Charlie Jones, Channarock Farms, has set up a scholarship fund that will award \$1000 scholarship. The Charlie Jones Memorial Scholarship supports education by providing scholarships to young men and women who are active in the Beefmaster breed and who are pursuing a higher education. Applicants must currently be a Junior, Regular or Life member of the SEBBA or the direct descendant of a current Regular or Life member of the SEBBA.

The Charlie Jones Memorial Scholarship will award 1 \$1000.00 (one-thousand dollar) scholarship in 2022. The SEBBA Scholarship Committee will review all scholarship applications and select the winners. Application deadline is June 1 of application year.

Once a qualified applicant's application has been determined complete and eligible for review, it will be considered by the SEBBA Scholarship Selection Committee.

Applicant Qualifications

- 1. Applicants must currently be a Junior, Regular or Life member of SEBBA or the direct descendent of a current Regular or Life member of SEBBA.
- 2. The applicant must be a graduating high school senior or must be enrolled in a junior college four-year college/university or other accredited institution of higher education for the fall term in which the scholarship is to be awarded. Applicants must have a minimum 2.5 GPA (cumulative) to be eligible.
- 3. The applicant has not reached their 25th birthday prior to January 1 of the year of application.
- 4. The scholarship must be applied to undergraduate studies and is applicable to any field of study.
- 5. If selected to receive a scholarship by the SEBBA Scholarship Selection Committee, the scholarship applicant will be required to verify their enrollment in an institution of higher education by September 30 with the B.E.E.F., before the scholarship award check can be issued. Failure to meet enrollment requirements will result in forfeit of the scholarship.
- 6. Should the recipient fail to complete at least one semester of full-time enrollment in an accredited or approved institution of higher education prior to June 30th of the application year for any reason, scholarship funds must be refunded to the The Charlie Jones Memorial Scholarship.

Application must be made each year. Past recipients of The Charlie Jones Memorial Scholarship can continue to apply for named scholarships unless specified otherwise by the SEBBA Scholarship Selection Committee. This application applies to the The Charlie Jones Memorial Scholarship.

All scholarship applications *MUST* be typewritten using a typewriter, word processor or computer to complete the application. Do not add extra pages. Do not use the back of pages. The type font size should be no smaller than 10 point. The application should be in the same format as the official application posted on the Beefmaster Educational Endowment Foundation website. *Please do not staple the pages or bind them in a report cover*.

The application may be reproduced on your computer, but the same allotted space must be given to each of the items and questions in the application. The application is **eight** (8) pages in length.

Your application MUST include a copy of your most current high school and/or college transcript. An unofficial fall semester transcript is acceptable as well.

The transcript(s) MUST be included with the scholarship application when mailed to the Southeastern Beefmaster Breeders Association. Transcripts sent separate from the scholarship application will not be accepted.

Your application MUST include three letters of recommendation. The individuals writing the recommendation letters should include their association with the applicant and a candid evaluation of the applicant's abilities, background, character, strengths, weaknesses, etc. The recommendations may come from employers, teachers, ag leaders, junior advisors, pastors, etc. They may NOT include applicants, parents, Beefmaster Breeders United board of directors, Beefmaster Breeders United employees, or SEBBA board of directors. The three letters of recommendation MUST be included with the application when it is mailed to the Southeastern Beefmaster Breeders Association. Letters of recommendation sent separate from the scholarship application will not be accepted.

JUNE 1st is the absolute deadline for mailing applications. NOTE: With regard to this deadline, materials mailed must be postmarked by the U.S. Postal Service on or before JUNE 1st.

Applications, privately metered, <u>will not</u> be accepted. Letters of recommendation and transcripts are required to be sent with the official scholarship application. We request this in order to help ensure that applicants submit a *complete and eligible* application to the Southeastern Beefmaster Breeders Association.

IMPORTANT FINAL REMINDER: <u>For a scholarship application to be considered complete and eligible for review by the Southeastern Beefmaster Breeders</u>
<u>Association Scholarship Selection Committee, the application MUST:</u>

- 1) Be signed and dated by the applicant
- 2) Include three letters of recommendation
- 3) Be U.S. Postal Service postmarked by June 1 of the application year
- 4) Include copy of most current high school and/or most current college transcript
- 5) Include member code of the applicant
